Also, is the memory card proprietary.

Im assuming that the card is not a typical sd or compact flash card too bad. I bought the machine on an impulse. I have the same machine and enjoy using it. I recently bought the precut 8x8 peel and stick sheets from Allstitch and I highly recommend them if you are going to do any hoopless embroidery. You got a great price Colleen The manual will tell you many things and Brother is usually pretty good about giving you several sheets of stabilizer and bobbin thread to start with.regular sewing thread you cant use, although I do on the top with bobbin thread on the bottom.Also have plenty of cdrw to download designs to as its not a good idea to keep designs on the computer should your computer crash and you will lose purchased designs from the web with them.storing that much also bogs your computer down. Your book should have a reference chart for that also. Ive been looking at some of the free patterns available online and was wondering if it is okay to save the pattern with a new name on the computer. Im pretty sure it would be okay to do this, but just wanted to make sure that it wouldnt cause a problem. Im trying to come up with a system to store the pes file, a picture of the image, and the other info size, thread count, color stop charts, etc. organized. I would hate to have to buy 20 colors to make one design. If a pattern calls for 4 different shades of one color, can you cheat and just use 1 or 2 shades instead. Do you wind your own bobbins. Is there a better brand or thread count, etc. Does the thread you use depend on the thickness of the fabric youre going to embroider. Oops! Make that 4 question! LOL I also put designs in their own directory or folder according to categories I collect. I finally trained the new computer to download directly to the cdrw so I dont have to do the transfer from desktop to cd route.one step saved.

There are 5 builtin monogramming fonts in 3 different sizes. These alphabets are great for creating names and phrases with your embroidery machine. The embroidery hoop area is 4" x 4".

The SE270D also has a builtin memory card slot which is compatible with Brothers extensive Embroidery Card Collection, Disney Embroidery Card Collection and our software PDesign and PEDBasic. It couldnt be easier to embellish your project with our SE270D embroidery system. The SE270D has 98 built in stitch functions and Brothers exclusive quickload thread cassette system. The cassette system threads your machine in 3 easy steps which even includes threading the needle for you. The bobbin system is also simple to use with the fast, automatic bobbin winder and onestep bobbin replacement with our quick set dropin bobbin. It is easy to select your stitch or embroidery pattern on this machine as it has a builtin LCD computerized touch screen panel. The built in stitches include 10 styles of onestep autosize buttonholes, builtin stretch stitches, garment construction stitches, decorative stitches heirloom stitches and quilting stitches. The stitch width and length are adjustable as well as the thread tension. There are accessories included for zipper insertion, darning, twin needle stitching, button hole sewing as well as sewing on buttons. The instructions on this machine are bilingual in English and Spanish. I bought this machine for my wife and admittedly I will probably use it as much as she will. I have not embroidered with it yet but I did use it to do a little sewing and I do have some observations. This is NOT a heavy duty machine. There is a lot of plastic on the machine and I mean a LOT. Parts like the spool posts that are all plastic that feel like they would easily break. The thread cassette feels like it is very fragile too. The machine is easy to load and while I must say when you first turn it on with the embroidery module attached it makes a lot of noise on start up, but it does sew very quiet and smooth compared to my older machines.

I was really concerned about using spools of thread that would only fit inside the thread cassette, but an attachment is supplied that snaps on top of the thread cassette that allows you to use larger spools of thread. I cant say I really like how you wind the bobbins and again the plastic spool post is very fragile. I think it could easily break if you were not careful with it. It does come loaded with tons of features that I have yet to use and I think if treated with care it will last a while. I just dont know if the wife will be as tender with it as I am. From the color of the light, Im guessing it uses an LED light although I have not physically confirmed that. If so the light should last a lifetime but it is a little dimmer then I would like. The touch screen is mono color and it would have been nice to have a color display, but what can you expect for the price. For what you get feature wise and what its capable of doing you really cant beat this machine for the money. Not only does it embroider but it sews as well and a machine with that capability alone will cost you many times more then what the brother costs. I feel it is a very good value for the money considering the alternatives and even factoring in the short comings of the machine. Just be careful with it and dont force anything. If Brother had only made a few parts like the spool posts and the foot lever out of metal, this would be a more robust machine for the user. Also, Im not sure I really like the thread cassette. Purchase good polyester embroidery threads otherwise thread breaks often. The advantage of a larger hoop is that you do not have to remove hoop as often since you can adjust design position within hoop with the SE270D sewing machine. To put blank space between words arrow over to the underscore

alphabet; to put a second, third, etc line, use the adjust location onscreen. If you embroider on hand towels, use a watersoluable stiffener. I love this sewing machine. Cost is affordable.

It was intimidating at first. Be patient. It does work. I love the builtin Micky Mouse designs. It is advantageous to purchase extra bobbins and white polyester bobbin threads. Winding bobbins on SE270D is easy and fast. It does a very nice job of stitching with a wide variety of different stitch types havent tried embroidering yet. Lightweight 15lb. Manual buttons are placed efficiently on the front of the machine, can be used without the foot pedal. The speed control is useful very slow to fast at a slide of a button. On both machines the bobbin winder tire didnt wear out, it turned to goo which dripped and smeared all over the interior. This took several hours to clean up. In order to get to the bobbin winder tire, you have to take the machine apart and remove the computer motherboard. The replacement tire is not standard, its much much smaller than the usual tire, it is very specific to these models. I ordered the replacement tires from sewingpartsonline. If you are going to buy either of these models, it would do well to ask the seller if the bobbin winding mechanism is working. My first attempts, even after reading the manual time and time again, were not that great. For some reason it was doing the first letter great but then any subsequent letter were being sewn over the first letter. I plan to keep trying. However, I have had no problems with regular sewing and it moves so quickly and I wouldnt trade it for another machine. Its window with the instruction manual virtually on it is great. When first using the machine it was very helpful. It tells you if anything is wrong, like when the thread is running low or if your pedal is plugged in when it is not supposed to be. It is very light weight but havent had any problems with it size. I have 3 sewing machines. It is very easy to use as far a sewing and learning how to do the embroidery. I just followed the instructions. I really bought it because I wanted to monogram scrubs and work shirts.

It does well but not like a pro job. I am only using the programs that the machine comes with. I have thought about looking into other fonts but havent had time. It does help if you use good thread and stabilizers. I have done a few of the embroidery designs are so far they look great. I would say they are better than some of the fonts for monogramming. I have 6 new great grand babies and hope to use the Disney part of the machine for them soon. I like all the things that it does, but I have to look up each thing and how to program it. I like that the machine is light and be transported easily. I tend to use my old machine because I know it well, and do not have to get the book out each time I want to do something. I am sure in time as I get use to the machine, I will love sewing with it. You need lots of free time to train yourself. A training CD would be nice. I had hoped to use it for sewing Christmas presents, but received it too late in December to figure out how to do something with it. This Christmas I should be a pro at it. My husband knew I wanted to learn machine embroidery but he wasnt about to pay 3 thousand dollars just in case I didnt stick with it I tend to do that. Unfortunetly for him, I LOVE it!! This machine is soooo easy to thread, and you change your thread ALOT when embroidering so buy extra cassettes. The designs preloaded in the machine are great,,,no need to buy extra cards unless youre like me and have to have all of the accessories. I have whipped up a set of valances in no time using this machine,,,ruffles and all!! The sewing and embroidery are very user friendly. I have had sewing machines for years so it was not because of lack of experience with them. I read the manual for 3 weeks and my husband said if you are not going to use it we will take it back to the store. So I decided to get over my fear of messing it up. I kept the manual beside me every time I used it till I felt confident enough to sew or embroidery without it.

I would definitely buy another one of these machines if I had it to do over. It has turned out to be the easiest to learn on and it sews just beautifully. Not only does it embroidery well, there are many fancy stitches you can use to decorate childrens or adult clothing, pillowcases, pillows,curtains, etc. There are 67 sewing stitches to be exact. It has a beautiful button hole stitch to use on applique for Sunbonnet Sue quilt blocks or whatever applique you like. There is also a feather stitch that is very

pretty for the edges of the applique items. People have ask me if I did these stitches by hand. They look so good. There is an eyelet tool that comes with it and an stitch you use to make the eyelet design and you use the tool to make the hole for it. It looks just like the eyelet fabric you buy. This is good for making lace trim with for many items. The scallop stitch is very pretty to go on the edge of the fabric when making pillowcases or curtains, tablecloths, or fancy dresses for little girls. One of the stitches looks just like cross stitch designs. I made a pair of curtains for my bathroom and used this stitch along the edge of the bottom and top and it looked really good. Another stitch I like to use is what I call the star stitch. It stitches little stars in a row. This makes a very decorative stitch to use for many items. There is a stippling stitch to use for quilting. I have used this for potholders and for small baby quilts. The end result was very successful. Buy the walking foot that goes with the machine. It is perfect for the quilting. There is also a guide attachment that goes with it that helps you keep the quilting in row. I forgot to mention the beautiful buttonholes it makes. It is so easy to use. The machine sews on buttons too. They will stay on better than when you hand sew them on. The triple stitch is great when your kids rip the seat of their pants. It will not come loose after you triple stitch it together.

I have only touched a few excellent points about buying this machine. It could go on and on. I would highly recommend this for a first machine for someone who has no sewing experience. It is great for the experienced seamstress, too. I have used it for three years and it still sews just perfect. I sew a lot so it is used very often. I have 2 embroidery machines and I have a lot less problems with this machine than the other more expensive one. The only dislike I have of this machine is that it does not use a large enough embroidery hoop. Once you get into the embroidery you will find more designs for larger patterns and you can only use the 4x4 size hoop with this machine. Besides the fancy stitches, there are many different feet to use, it cuts the thread, and automatically threads the needle for you after you set it up. There are many beautiful embroidery designs built into the machine. Lots of fonts for doing Monogramming for towels, pillowcases, or clothing. Perfect for the home sewer. The machine is really easy to use, once the directions are understood. Sewing is SEW easy! The autothreading is wonderful especially for older eyes. The bobbin also couldnt be easier. The builtin features are so plentiful and something for everything!!! Embroidery is fun! The trick is using GOOD QUALITY embroidery thread. Some threads such as the funky glow in the dark threads are fine with some fabrics and not so fine with others. The preloaded images are fun and I had a ton of things whipped up without purchasing an extra memory card. Easy to do low end manipulations and all the images can be resized including the upper and lowercase letters.
